Notes for Candidates

Taking exams can be a daunting experience so here's some information on what to expect when you enter the exam hall.

Invigilators

Invigilators supervise the exam and make sure the rules are followed. Follow any instructions given by the Invigilator and ask them for help if you feel unwell or upset.

Arriving late

For your own peace of mind, **arrive 10 minutes before the exam**. If you're late, the Chief Invigilator in charge will tell you if you can sit the exam.

In the exam room

During the exam, you're only allowed items needed for the exam. You're **not** allowed:

- electronic devices including mobile phones, MP3 players, tablets and smartwatches
- calculator or dictionary - except in specified subjects and these should meet SQA regulations
- books, notes, sketches, paper of any kind

Only bring a clear pencil case in to the exam, and if using your own dictionary for Modern Languages exams, make sure you get it checked by an invigilator first.

Conduct

- Don't copy from someone else or share your work with anyone else.
- Don't use text language or any abusive/discriminatory language or images in your answers.
- Don't be disruptive in the exam room.
- Don't share equipment with anyone else.



Question papers and answer booklets

Check that you have the correct exam question paper and let the invigilator know if you don't. Read the instructions on the front of each question paper and follow them carefully.

If you need extra paper, ask the Invigilator and remember to put your name the exam and your date of birth on any paper before putting it inside the question paper.

Writing your answers

Write neatly with black or blue ink. Do not use gel pens - these can sometimes cause your answers to fade. If using unlined answer books, leave a 1cm of space between lines, to make sure markers can read your writing.

Do not use text language, or any abusive, offensive or discriminatory language or images in your answers.

Rough work

Remember to cross out all unwanted answers and rough work before you hand in your exam.

Leaving the exam room

If you've answered as much as you can, the Invigilator can let you leave early, depending on the length of the exam. Hand in your answer booklet and question paper (and their contents) to the Invigilator before you leave or you could lose all the marks.

Absence

If you can't sit the exam for any valid reason, tell your teacher/lecturer. If you feel ill or upset during the exam, tell the Invigilator.
