Hockey Leaders Course

To improve your knowledge of the game, manage groups, and introduce basic rules through small sided games.

- 10am-4pm on Monday 2 and Tuesday 3 April (2 days)
- North Inch Community Campus, astro turf pitch + classroom
- Candidates will cover the theory part of the course and gain practical experience by delivering (under supervision) at the Perthshire Hockey Easter Camp which is running at the same time.
- Age: 14 years+

Hockey Umpire Level 1 Course

To learn practical umpiring elements.

- 10am-4pm on Wednesday 4 April.
- North Inch Community Campus, astro turf pitch + classroom
- Age 14 years+

Candidates will be required to:

- complete an online rules test
- attend the course where they will discuss and then gain practical umpiring experience at the Perthshire Hockey Easter Camp which is running at the same time.
- Undertake a practical test

Candidates can do one or both courses.

The courses are free of charge to candidates but they must volunteer up to 20 hours in a school or club setting.

Terms & conditions

- As part of the Project, you will be expected to volunteer at least 20 hours in a school or community club setting. Your Active Schools Coordinator can help you find a placement.
- School staff will not be present during the course.
- It is your responsibility to make your own travel arrangements to and from the course.
